What can you share with someone else?

#### The Chorlton Method of Bible Study

is a simple template to get the most out of God's Word and kick off discussion.

- First, pray (as a group or individually) that God may speak to you through reflecting on God's Word.
- ▶ Read the passage to yourself then hear the passage read several times by different members of the group.
- There are nine simple questions to prompt your thinking and reflections.
- Spend some time considering the questions on your own.
- Join in with the rest of the group to share your ideas and experiences.
- Remember! There aren't always 'right' and 'wrong' responses to these types of question.
